Project Summary: The Santee-Lynches Regional Council of Governments is requesting bids that include the playground equipment, the safety surface, and the installation of all equipment. The playground equipment should include play components for children ages 2-12, with an emphasis on equipment designed for children aged 5-10 years old. The equipment can be provided in one or more structures. The playground should accommodate the widest possible range of activities that will provide fun, promote physical fitness, and encourage social interaction. Among the play activities that should be considered are balancing, climbing, crawling, hanging, imagining, manipulating, pushing, pulling, riding, seesawing, sitting, sliding, swinging, and whirling. The playground equipment can be made of metal, plastic, or a combination. The color of the equipment shall be earth-tone colors. The equipment proposed shall include at least two (2) metal benches.
